

STATE OFFICER CANDIDATE AGREEMENT

PURPOSE

To become a State Officer of Oregon HOSA requires a commitment on the part of all parties concerned. In order to make that commitment, each party must understand their responsibility in this leadership training. In order for a candidate to be eligible for office, this Agreement must be signed by all parties indicated.

IF ELECTED, the CANDIDATE agrees to:

1. I will dedicate my year to serving the HOSA organization. I will serve my entire term of office, will promote the goals and objectives of HOSA, and will project a desirable image of HOSA at all times. I will abide by the policies of Oregon HOSA.
2. I will participate in all activities scheduled by the Program Coordinator or the Executive Council of the Oregon Association of HOSA. Required scheduled activities include the following (dates are tentative):

- **August** **Summer Executive Meeting**
- **October** **Fall Leadership Showcase**
- **December** **Spring Conference Planning**
- **April** **Spring Conference & Pre-Conference Meeting**

AGREEMENT

If elected, I intend to fulfill my obligations to this office and the Oregon Association of Health Occupation Students of America. This means I will attend **ALL** of the meetings identified above and fulfill all the responsibilities of my designated office. In the event that I cannot fulfill my term of office (for reasons other than illness or moving out of my region/state), I will reimburse the state association, my region and my chapter for any expenses they have paid me, such as travel, lodging and other items. The State Office reserves the right to place me on **probation** for non-attendance of the aforementioned official obligations. My officer position can be **terminated** if I consequently fail to fulfill the condition of my probation.
