

# HOSA MEMBERSHIP

**Secondary:** secondary students enrolled in health occupations or health science classes who have paid their annual membership dues.

**Postsecondary:** students enrolled in postsecondary programs at less than a baccalaureate level and have paid annual membership dues.

**Collegiate:** students enrolled in a baccalaureate or graduate degree program and have paid annual membership dues.

**Professional:** health professionals and other members of the community who support the HOSA program and pay annual membership fees. These members shall not vote, hold office or compete for awards.

**Alumni:** former active members in good standing with the chapter and have paid annual membership dues. They may not vote, hold office or enter competitive events,

**Associate:** students not enrolled in health occupations or health science technology programs, but who are interested in a career in the health care field. They must pay annual membership fees, but they may not vote, hold office or compete except in Category III events.

**Honorary:** persons who have made a significant contribution to health occupations/health science technology education or HOSA. They will be approved by the Board of Directors and are life-time members. They do not pay membership fees.
