

OREGON HOSA MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility: A student who is or has been enrolled in a health sciences education program and persons associated with, participating in, or supporting health occupations education in a professional capacity, and is a member of a local chapter of the Oregon Association of HOSA.

The Oregon Association of HOSA shall recognize individual members only through a local student chapter.

Each local student chapter shall govern membership eligibility.

Individual members shall be recognized as active voting members.

Dues: No member shall be considered active and in good standing unless she/he pays full state and national dues.

The membership year shall be from the beginning date of school for one full calendar year.

State chartering membership dues shall be \$10 per local chapter.

Dates: No memberships shall be accepted after November 1 except:

- 1) Those students who have enrolled in health sciences education classes after November 1.
- 2) New chapters
- 3) Students who enroll in health sciences education classes for the first time at mid-term. Their memberships will not be accepted after March 1.

ADVISOR REQUIREMENTS

ALL ADVISORS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSUREING THEIR CHAPTER'S COMPETITORS ARE MEMBERS OF BOTH STATE AND NATIONAL HOSA BY NOVEMBER 1 OR MARCH 1 BEFORE THEY COMPETE AT THE STATE CONFERENCE.

AFTER THE COMPETITION, IF IT IS DETERMINED THAT STUDENTS WERE NOT MEMBERS, THEY WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DISQUALIFIED.
