

OREGON HOSA STATE OFFICER UNIFORM POLICY

The Oregon HOSA officer shall wear the HOSA uniform at all official functions. Examples of official functions may include but are not limited to: competitive events, official business meetings, board meetings and any time the officer represents HOSA at a public activity or meeting.

An Official HOSA Blazer will be provided by Oregon HOSA for the officer to wear throughout the year. The blazer will be returned to the Oregon HOSA Program Coordinator at the closing of the State Leadership Conference.

THE OFFICIAL OFFICER UNIFORM POLICY IS:

1. Official HOSA blazers – males and females
A tailored navy blazer with emblem affixed over the heart.
2. Shirt/blouse for female members
A neatly pressed white tailored shirt or blouse
Jewel necklines with lace, ruffles or full edged collars are not acceptable
3. Shirt for male members
A neatly pressed white closed neck tailored dress shirt suitable for use with a tie.
4. Male members ~ solid navy or maroon tailored long tie
5. Official HOSA member and/or an officer pin
Should be centered on the left lapel of the jacket
National HOSA trading pins may be worn on the official HOSA Blazer.
6. Footwear should be appropriate to the overall appearance of the uniform
The shoe color should be consistent among the group
Black or navy shoes are recommended
7. The Oregon HOSA officer may wear minimal jewelry.
Acceptable jewelry is limited to a watch, no more than two small finger rings and one pair of small earrings in the female ear.
